Financial Report:

Membership levels are above pre covid levels and income levels at approx £28,000 Subscription fees and approx £22,000 Court Fee income.

The subscription fee have been passed to CALSA.

Court repair expenses, software and general costs of £8,000 result in £14,000 surplus retained in Squash & Racketball which will go toward the court refurb program.
